It is a wine made with 100% Tinta del País (Tempranillo) grapes from vineyards planted by our family at the beginning of the 20th century in the areas of Quintana del Pidio, located in the heart of the Ribera del Duero.

The ripening of the grapes has been exceptional and complete, balanced acidity, also achieving high values in phenolic parameters, a particularly favourable situation for aging wines.

In the production cellar, the destemmed grapes are fermented in small stainless steel tanks with a capacity of 5,000 litres, which helps us maintain rigorous temperature control, a determining factor during production to obtain this wine.

In the aging cellar, the wine rests in French and American oak barrels for 14 months. Later, to assemble and soften the tannins of the barrel and the variety, it will remain in the bottle, which will also provide refinement and harmony in the whole of its body.

TASTING NOTES

VISUAL

A beautiful, lively and very intense garnet red colour, a sign of its good aging.

NOSE

Ripe grapes of great aromatic richness, spicy, floral, mineral notes and the toasted aromas of the barrel achieve an excellent combination with the fruity content of the wine.

TASTING

Above all, strength stands out, a reflection of the good grape from which it comes, a feeling of fullness, as well as softness. The tannins of the grape blend with those of the barrel and the aftertaste is a good reminder of red fruits, mineral touches, spices and toasts. Ready for full tasting, due to the extraordinary quality of the vintage, it will improve in the coming years.

The pairing is perfect for the new cuisine based on cheeses, sausages, all kinds of roast meats and stews.

To fully enjoy the sensations of this wine, we recommend drinking temperature between 15° and 18° C.
