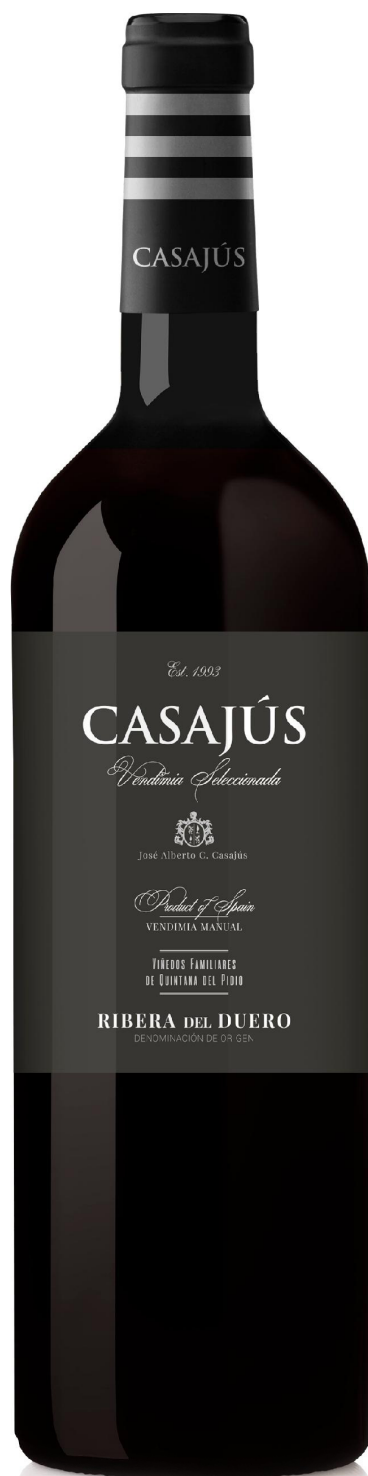




CASAJÚS

Vendimia Seleccionada

RIBERA DEL DUERO

DENOMINACIÓN DE ORIGEN

This is a wine made at Bodegas J.A. Calvo Casajús in the municipality of Quintana del Pidio in the heart of the Denomination of Origin Ribera del Duero, in the province of Burgos (Spain).

The grapes we use are of a native variety, called Tinta del País. During the harvest the fruit was carefully selected and hand-picked from the small vineyards planted by our family in 1920.

In the winery, the destemmed grapes are fermented in small stainless steel tanks with a capacity of 10,000 litres, which helps us to rigorously control temperatures and to maintain freshness and aromatic potential in the wines. Its subsequent passage through French oak barrels makes it a wine rich in nuances, a unique example of the Tinta del País variety.

TASTING NOTES

VISUAL

This wine has a medium / high layer ruby red / purple colour.

NOSE

Intense with many nuances and aromas of sweet berries, truffles and spices with notes of liquorice typical of the variety.

TASTING

Powerful wide-ranging flavor, with an initial impression of velvety, followed by a cascade of blackberry and hints of liquorice and minerals.

Its aging in the barrel makes it a wide wine rich in tannins.

The pairing is perfect for the new cuisine based on cheeses, sausages, all kinds of roast meats and stews.

To fully enjoy the sensations of this wine, we recommend drinking temperature between 14° and 16° C.
